General situation

Austrian admissions reached 2014: 15.075.317.

(2013: 15.839.378, 2012: 16.738.141). This represents a decrease of 4,8% or 764.061 tickets. The ratio per habitant was 2013 at 1.87 visits per year.

Austrian Films and Co productions reached 2013 about 458.900 admissions. This is about 3,2 %.

In 2013, 344 films were released (2012: 360, 2011: 318 films)
In 2013, a total of 400 films were screened in cinemas (2012: 413, 2011: 364 films)

The average price for cinema tickets rose to 8,23 Euros in 2013 (2012 7,79 E, 2011: 7,59 E) Art Cinemas theatres tickets are less expensive, and in multiplexes they are more.

The number of movie theatres in Austria decreased 2013 to 548 screens in 133 complexes. Digital screens: 537. 98,0%

Art cinema sector

This sector had an decrease of admissions in 2014, between -4,57% and - 0,95%.

33,3% films were USA releases and 57,0% European ones . USA films made 73,7% of the admissions and European Films made 25,1%.
